

Polish Cultural Centre in Daugavpils

Polish Culture Centre in Daugavpils popularizes Polish language, the culture, the history and national heritage. The Centre organizes exhibitions, concerts, festivals and other cultural events.

The Polish House building was purchased in 1930 with resources gathered by the Polish community, during the Soviet times the building was expropriated, but was returned to the Poles after Latvia regained its independence and in 1997 the Polish Culture Centre was established with support of Daugavpils City Council. The Polish Society “Promen” and the Polish Culture Center work now in the Polish house and there also the self-governing groups perform their activities: the mixed choir “Promen”, the folklore group “Kukulecka”, the children’s theatre group and the vocal and instrumental ensemble.
