Cultural-historical objects

Description: The church was confirmed in 1831. in honour of St. Miķelis Ercenģelis. It was built from boulders, without towers, in the style of ancient basilica, 30 x 16 x 9 m big. The church has three outdoors and 14 windows. Around the church is yard with the stone fence. In the same time with the church in the front of it was built the bell-tower from boulders with the gate. The tower has one bronze bell. Not far from the bell-tower is original wooden cross from 1889. The fence has concrete roof. The church has galvanized iron roof, which was covered in 1976.
